

## Esteban Guerrero

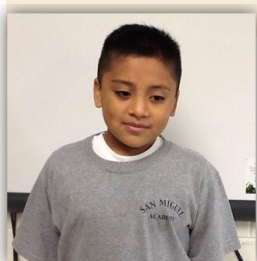
